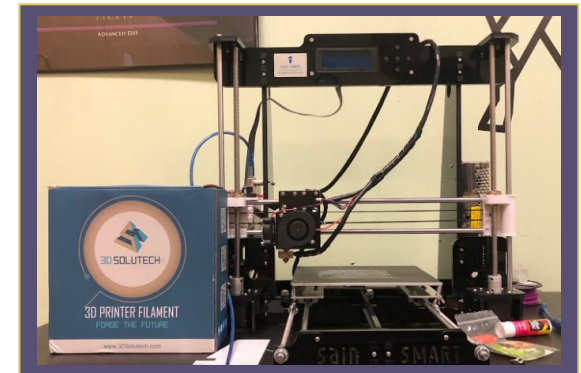

 - Research the company!



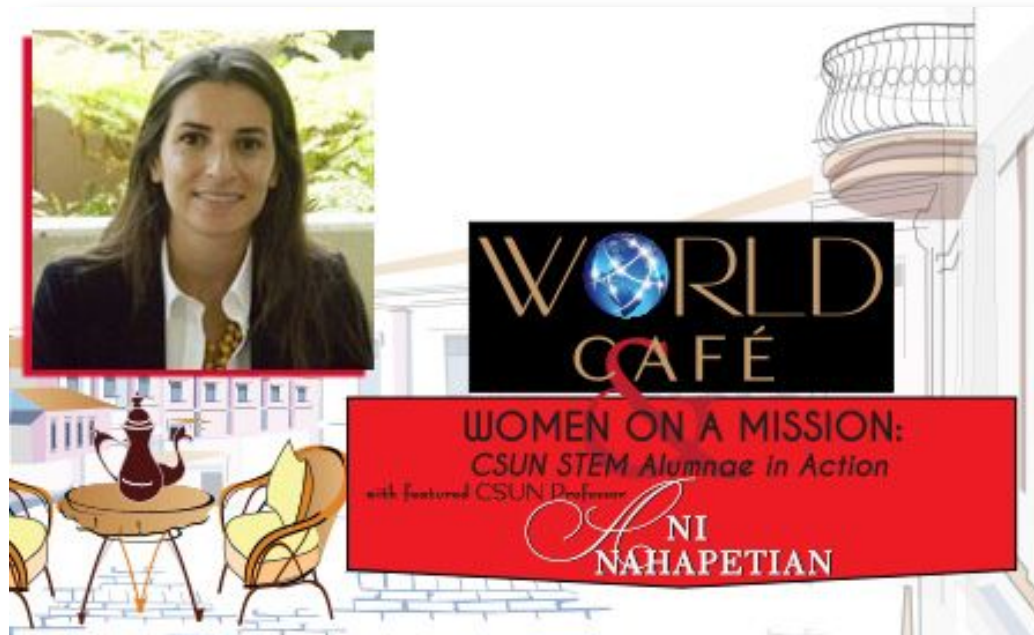

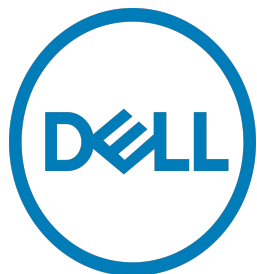
