Vice President

- The President's right hand (wo)man - fills in for President when she cannot fulfill her duties
- Primary representative for the executive board within the chapter
- Responsible for communication between clubs
- Facilitates planned club activities with other board members





President

- Primary representative for the chapter within the College & AS/University
- Primary contact with SWE LA and the Nat'l Organization
- Responsible for updating and maintaining club documentation with the Nat'l Org
- Responsible for running both board and GBMs, including:
 - Planning semester activities with input from rest of the board
 - Booking rooms, reserving parking, etc.
 - Coordinating "day-of" activities, like food deliveries, guest pick-ups, set-up and take-down, etc.
